

FINDING THE FULL TEXT OF ARTICLES



Sometimes when you are searching for articles in databases you find articles without links to the full text. Often we do have access to the full text and you need to search for the article via the library homepage.

Copy the journal title that the article was published in and make a note of the publication details, e.g. date of publishing, volume and issue number.

SEARCHING FOR ARTICLE USING 'JOURNAL SEARCH'

On the library homepage click on the **Journal search** tab and search for the journal title. This will take you to a page where you can search the journal's past and current issues.



Find your article by clicking on **Select Year** and then selecting the year and what issue the article was published in.

Remember to use the publication details you copied earlier. In this case we would select 2015 and then choose Volume 63, Issue 12.



This will bring up the particular issue your article was published in. Scroll through the list of articles and select yours. You now have access to the full text!



SEARCHING FOR ARTICLE USING 'LIBRARY SEARCH'

If you cannot find the journal via **Journal Search** try searching for the journal using the **Library Search** tab. As before type in the name of the journal.

APPLYING FOR AN INTER-LIBRARY LOAN

If you cannot find the full text anywhere you can apply for the article to be emailed to you via Inter-Library Loan. This is a University service which is free for students.

To bring up the form for applying for an Inter-Library loan go to the library homepage and click on the box Inter-Library Loans underneath the search bar.


